



To All Sacramento Gun Club Members & Guests:

Effective July 20, 2016

As you all are aware Sacramento Gun Club is a relatively new business. When we started planning to bring this business to the Sacramento region, we looked at which aspects of a gun range and retail store would be of the most value to our members and the public at large. We spent a great deal of time determining specifically what we could provide in the way of services.

One of those services was that of an on-site Gunsmith. We then decided to have an inside Gunsmith that was an integrated part of our operation. We proceeded to fit out a state of the art gunsmith area and operation and upon our initial analysis determined that our course of action was sound. Unfortunately, that decision has not proven to be correct, and we have had to make the hard decision to end our in-house gunsmith operation. Our intent is to distribute a Request for Proposal within the firearms and shooting arena to find a seasoned gunsmith who would like to take over the gunsmith operation as his own business from within the Sacramento Gun Club facility. As we have learned since our opening this format is what is customarily found within the great majority of gun ranges and we feel it will be much more beneficial to our members and customers to have this type of arrangement at Sacramento Gun Club.

We have in the interim been in contact with a group of very skilled and licensed gunsmiths who will take on any of our backlogged work to complete. For those of you who presently have a firearm in for repair we will offer you two choices. 1) You can pick up your firearm and take it elsewhere, and we will not charge you for doing so. 2) You can leave the firearm with us and we will have it repaired by our outside gunsmiths at the same price you were quoted by our gunsmith, provided that the scope of the repairs does not materially change. All quick cleans provided in your membership will continue to be honored under the temporary services.

I am sure each of you has been in the situation of realizing that you have gotten into an area where you didn't have adequate resources or expertise to manage a complex operation, and that is where we find ourselves with our current gunsmith operation. Please be assured that all other aspects of Sacramento Gun Club are steadily improving and we will continue to strive to provide our region the safest and best shooting experience. We hope that this transition from our in-house gunsmith operation to an outside vendor will be brief and that the new business will be on-line in the near future.
